





Report on project grant received under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan

Bajaj Institute of Technology, Wardha submitted a project titled 'Installation of a solar microgrid in the school building' for the Zilla Parishad School in the adopted village of Chana (Takli), District Wardha. The project was approved by the Subject Expert Group (SEG) and National Steering Committee (NSE) of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan on December 19, 2019, under the customisation of technology. Unnat Bharat Abhiyan approved a grant of Rs. 50,000/- for implementing the project under Rural Energy Systems. Bajaj Institute of Technology Wardha has successfully installed a 1 kW solar rooftop system for the school, spending a total of Rs. 93,159/- for the installation.

This project will ensure a 24-hour electricity supply in the school and reduce the electricity bill. It will benefit the students, school, and village."
