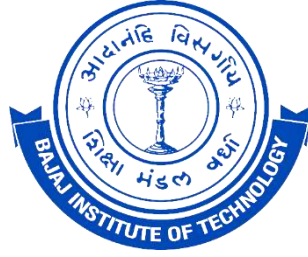

What Constitutes Ragging?

Any disorderly conduct, whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing,
OR
handling with rudeness any other student, any undisciplined / malicious activity which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm
OR
to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior student
OR
asking the students to do any act or perform something which such student will not do in the ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of a fresher or a junior student.

Information

- Ragging is a punishable offence under various sections of IPC, UGC Regulations on Curbing The Menace Of Ragging In Higher Educational Institutions, 2009 and under Section 23 and Section 10 of the AICTE Act, 1987.
- Any act of Ragging is strictly prohibited inside the institute campus and hostel.
- Involvement in Ragging may lead to suspension from attending classes, withholding/withdrawing scholarships and other benefits, debarring from appearing in exam, withholding results, debarring the student from representing in any national, international or youth festival, suspension from hostel, expulsion from institution and barring from admission in any other institution, fine upto Rs. 25000/-
- CCTV cameras are installed at necessary locations.
- Members of anti-ragging committee make rounds and are vigilant.
